SCHOLARSHIP INFORMATION:

WHAT: Seven (7) scholarships available for swimming and seven (7) scholarships available for diving (see page 2 for level descriptions).

WHO: Adults and children aged 4 and up who are Harvard Ed Portal members. *Please note:* divers must be able to swim and at least 6 years old.

COST: Upon notification of receipt of a scholarship, a \$50 non-refundable program registration fee will be required.

SWIM & DIVE SCHOOL INFORMATION:

WHERE: Harvard University's Blodgett Pool is located at the corner of N. Harvard St. and Soldiers Field Rd. Access to the Pool is through the Murr Athletic Center, 65 N. Harvard St., Allston. Please use the door on the right-hand side of the building.

INSTRUCTORS: Instruction is taught by members of the Harvard swimming and diving teams, under the supervision of the varsity coaching staff. The purpose of the school is to give individualized and small group instruction to participants.

SWIM AND DIVE LEVEL DESCRIPTIONS

Youth classes (Levels 1-4) are 30-minute lessons for younger students; adult and diving classes are 45 minutes.

<p>S1 (YOUTH ONLY): Non-Swimmer</p>	<p>No swimming experience necessary. Ages 4-18</p>	
<p>S2 (YOUTH ONLY): Beginner</p>	<p>The swimmer is comfortable in the water and can put their face in the water and float on their own.</p>	
<p>S3 (YOUTH ONLY): Advanced Beginner</p>	<p>The swimmer is able to swim basic freestyle and backstroke. This level may swim in deep water.</p>	
<p>S4 (YOUTH ONLY): Intermediate</p>	<p>The swimmer has basic knowledge of butterfly and breaststroke. This level swims in deep water.</p>	
<p>S1-6 (ADULTS ONLY): Intermediate through Advanced</p>	<p>Participants are placed in small groups of two swimmers to one coach. Lessons are geared specifically to what participants want to learn/improve</p>	
<p>D1 Beginning Diving</p>	<p>Participants must be 6 years of age or older. Participants must be able to swim back to the edge of the pool after diving, but no previous diving experience is necessary.</p>	
<p>D2 Intermediate Diving</p>	<p>Participants must be 6 years of age or older. Participants must be able to swim back to the edge of the pool after diving. Previous diving lessons with our program or other experience recommended.</p>	
<p>D3 Advanced Diving</p>	<p>Participants must be 6 years of age or older. Participants must be able to swim back to the edge of the pool after diving. Prior diving lessons or team experience required.</p>
